Employee Assistance Program (EAP)

Everyone has problems from time to time that are just too big to handle alone. Sometimes they affect job performance, sometimes they do not.

Because your employer values your personal well-being, as well as the work you do, it offers the Employee Assistance Program (EAP). The EAP will assist you in getting the help you need when you need it.

Who can use the EAP?

The program is available to you and your eligible family members.

What does it provide?

The Employee Assistance Program provides confidential access to experienced professionals who can help you or, if necessary, refer you to appropriate resources. Often the EAP can offer you tools, insights and resources to help you address your area of concern.

Who provides the service?

To best serve you and your family, our Employee Assistance Program has contracted with St. Charles Medical Center's Behavioral Health Services team. Through this relationship, we offer access to professionals at St. Charles as well as a number of licensed community practitioners.

Is there a fee?

You are eligible for up to three visits per calendar year at no charge.

What kind of issues can the EAP help me with?

Your Employee Assistance Program can help you with the following issues and concerns:

- ◆ Stress management
- ◆ Marital or family difficulties
- ◆ Personal/emotional concerns
- ◆ Depression
- ◆ Alcohol/substance abuse
- ◆ Grief/loss counseling
- ◆ Anxiety management
- ◆ Anger management
- ◆ Medical conditions
- ◆ Chronic pain

Is this service really confidential?

Yes. Any information you share with your EAP counselor will be kept *confidential*. An EAP counselor must obtain an employee's written consent prior to the release of any information. Your employer and coworkers will not have any knowledge of your request for help.
