




In 2022, the Central Oregon median wage for all occupations was \$20.83 an hour. Healthcare practitioners and technical occupations paid the highest median hourly wage (\$49.15), followed by management occupations (\$39.97), and computer and mathematical occupations (\$38.78). Food preparation and serving related occupations, on the other hand, paid the lowest median hourly wage (\$15.01) of any occupation group. This was followed by personal care and service occupations (\$15.13), and sales and related occupations (\$15.63).
