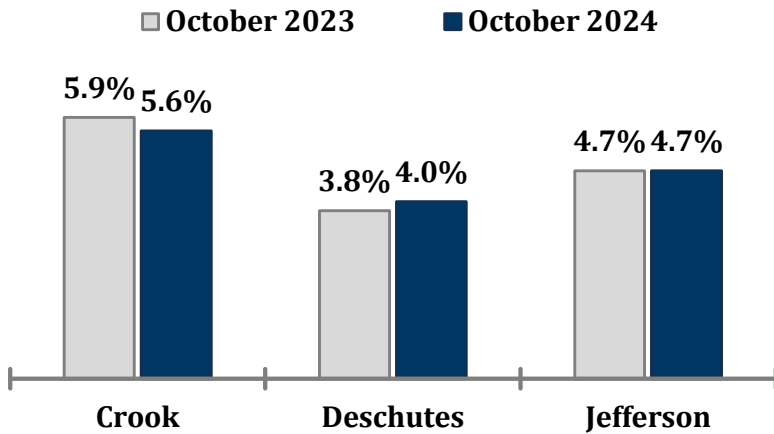

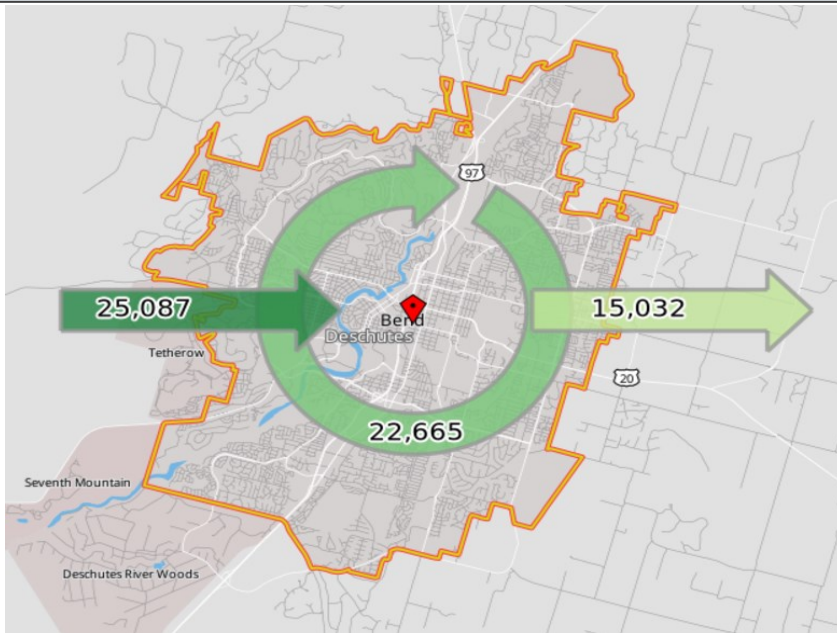

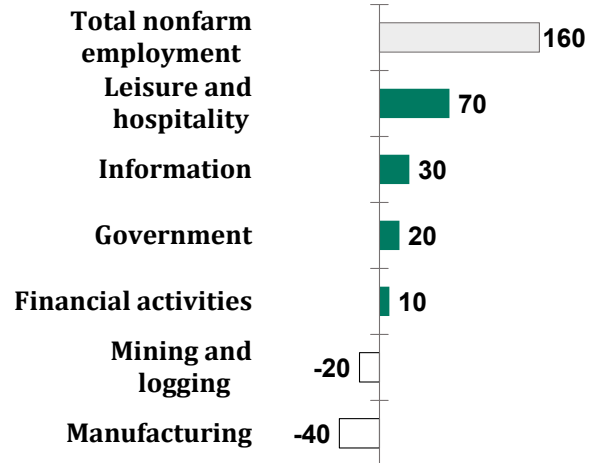
According to the most recent U.S. Census Bureau OnTheMap data, 39.9% (15,032) of workers living in Bend in 2022 commuted outside of the city to work. This is a slight increase from previous years, 38.7% (14,129) in 2021 and 36.5% (12,759) in 2020.

Comparatively, 52.5% (25,087) of individuals employed in Bend, commuted into the city for work in 2022. This number was as high as 55% (17,273) in 2009. However, it has been around 47-53% in recent years.

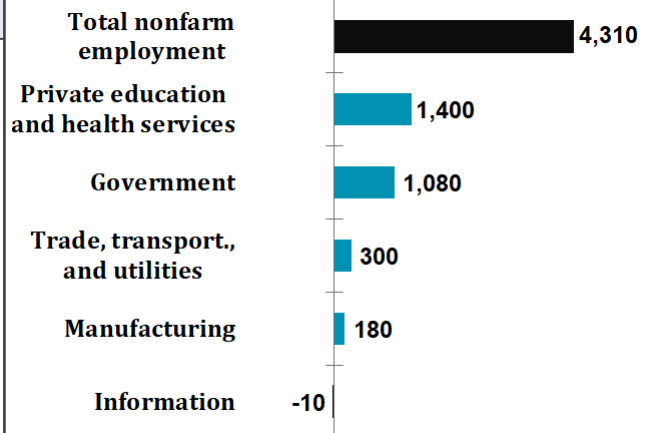
The percentage of workers who are both employed and living in Bend is 47.5% (22,665). This number has decreased over the years, in 2011 there was a high of 52.2% (22,019), and a low of 45% (14,142).

### Select Industry Gains and Losses (Over-the-year net employment change)

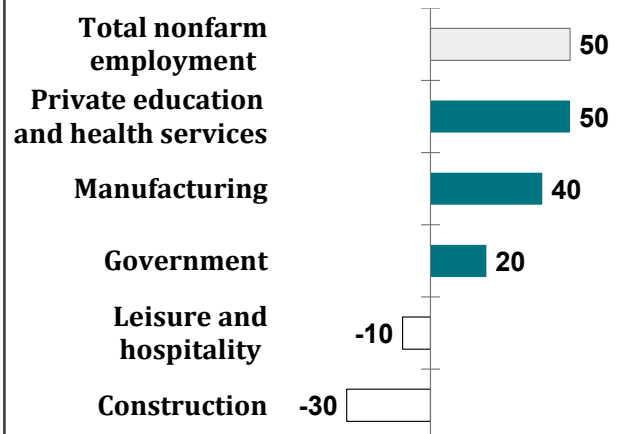
